History & examination

Key diagnostic factors show all erythema migrans (common) Typical rash that occurs 1 to 2 weeks after a tick bite (range, 1 to 36 days). [2] [3] [4] Central clearing is classic but not necessary for diagnosis. constitutional symptoms (common) Fever, headache, myalgias, fatigue, or arthralgias may occur after infection. Nausea and vomiting are rare.

Other diagnostic factors show all facial palsy (uncommon) arthritis or arthralgia (uncommon) regional lymphadenopathy (uncommon) stiff neck (uncommon) lymphocytoma cutis (uncommon) acrodermatitis chronica atrophicans (uncommon) AV block or myopericarditis (uncommon) radiculopathy (uncommon)

Risk factors Strong exposure to infected animals outdoor activities tick bite duration
